

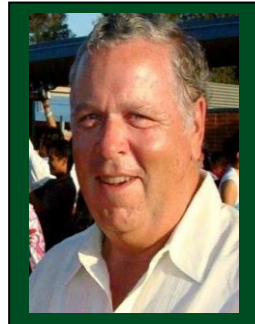

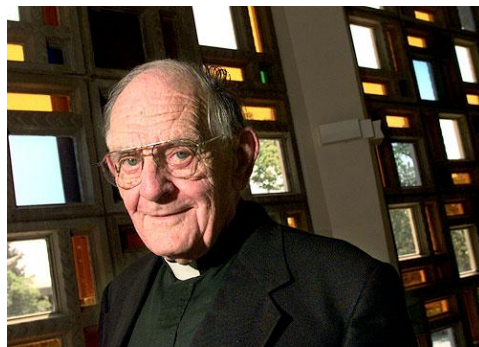

On Tuesday, December 1, 2015, Juliana Gerace addressed the club members with her presentation on "HOPE". Juliana has served the Diocese of Orange for over 20 years in youth ministry; as a religion teacher and department chair at Santa Margarita High School, director of children's faith formation and adult faith formation. She presently works for Fr. Robert Spitzer, S.J., and is a faculty member of the Magis Institute and visits various parishes to present on topics of faith. She has completed her Doctorate in Ministry in 2010, and has recently published her first novel. (See book cover insert on right). She and her husband Vincent live in St. Cecilia's parish in Tustin.

Juliana opened her presentation reminding us that as believers, we already acknowledge the Incarnation that we focus upon during Advent, and that we are awaiting Jesus' second coming. This adds many layers to our Advent prayer and devotion. We live in times that try our hope. We are called as baptized, committed missionary disciples to bring hope to our world, and to those around us. The virtue of hope is a powerful force and one that we are already gifted with...through our baptism. Cardinal John Henry Neumann said: "I have a mission, God has created me to do Him some definite service, He has committed some work to me that He has not committed to another. I have my mission, I may never know it in this life, but I shall be told it in the next. I am a link in a chain, a bond of connection between persons, He has not created me for naught, I shall do good, I shall do His work. I shall be an angel of peace, a preacher of truth. In my own place, while not intending it, if I do but keep His commandments, therefore I will trust Him whatever I am, I cannot be thrown away....if I am in sickness my sickness may serve him, in perplexity, my perplexity may serve him, if I am in sorrow my sorrow may serve Him. He does nothing in vain. He knows what He is about, He may take away my friends, He may throw me among strangers, He may make me feel desolate, He may make my spirit sink, hide my future from me, still, He knows what He is about." These words reflect how beautiful it is to live in hope.

Pope Francis calls us to live, not just in hope, but to a heroic level of hope! We place our trust in Christ's promises and in placing our trust and hope, not on ourselves, but on the grace of the Holy Spirit.

What is God's dream for us ?

Let us set our internal compasses to align with that message of hope. Many thanks to Juliana for her insightful presentation....!

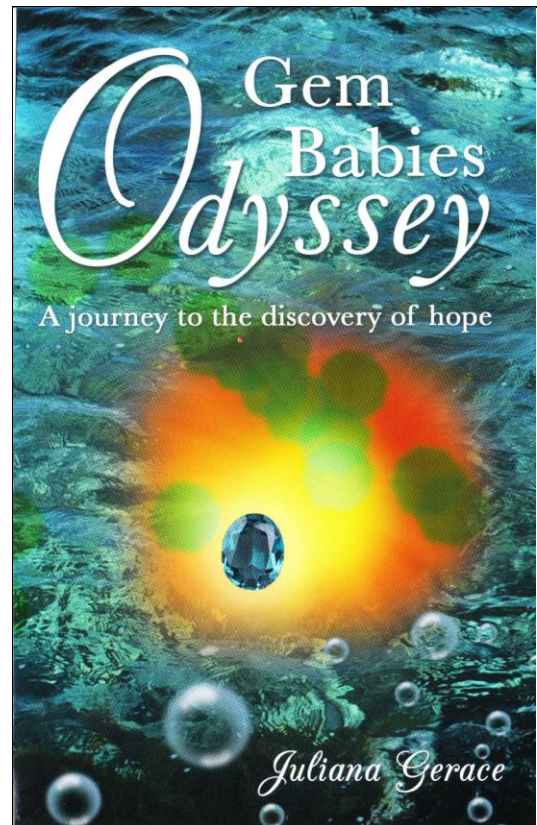
