---MEMBERSHIP---NEW APPROACHES

Recently the Board of Trustees discussed at length our current situation regarding our limited success in recruiting new members into our Saint Paul Serra Club. - In addition, you may be particularly encouraged to bring friends/relatives to some of our meetings such as our upcoming October meeting with Archbishop Hebda as guests in order to introduce them to the many interesting and beneficial aspects of Serra and to inform them how important being a Serran is to our Church.


