April 7th Speaker—Father Sam Brand Topic—Vocation Story



Background

Fr. Sam was one of four boys and grew up in St. Elizabeth Ann Seaton Parish, where he attended grade school. He graduated from Bishop Carroll High School and attended Newman University for one year. He attended St. John Vianney seminary in Minnesota and was ordained a priest in May of 2014 by Bishop Carl Kemme. His home parish at that time was St. Catherine of Siena in northwest Wichita.

His Journey

Fr. Jim Billinger was his pastor in grade school, who made a very strong impression on Sam. He was a joyful and very holy priest, whose example Sam really liked. Fr. Jarrod Lies was his chaplain at Bishop Carroll High School and was also an inspiring example for Sam. Many people and friends had mentioned to Sam that he would

make a good priest. One day when he and his dad were driving down the road his dad said,"I think you would make a great priest". This had a profound impact on Sam's thinking about his future.

Attending Newman University

While attending Newman University he found he was not interested in the studies and started skipping classes. Fr. Tatro called him out and they discussed his interest in the seminary. A week later they called Fr. Matt McGinness and Sam was applying for the seminary. He found this was the decision and vocation he wanted to do. In the seminary he got to experience the various aspects if the priesthood and make many new friends.

His first year as Parochial Vicar (Associate Pastor)

After ordination he was assigned to the Church of The Magdalen under Fr. York the pastor. He has experienced a lot of firsts this year and it has been a lot of fun and very rewarding. He loves being a priest, visiting the sick, teaching the 8th grade students, helping out at Kapaun Mt. Carmel High School and holding retreats for them.

He basked in the amazing experience of celebrating the Easter Triduum liturgy as a priest. A very memorable experience was celebrating an all school Mass at Kapaun Mt. Carmel on Ash Wendnesday and using Fr. Kapaun's chalice.

We are blessed to have such good and excited new young priests in our diocese with prospects of many more to come. Our prayers of petition and thanksgiving must continue as these young men are welcomed and supported in their discernment of God's call to the priesthood.

April 21st Speaker—Christina Streeter Topic—Holy Family Camp

The speaker for this evening was Christina Streeter, who works with the Persons with Disabilities for the Diocese, and is the coordinator of the Holy Family Camp which takes place each summer. Christina is a member of St. Francis parish with her husband and four children.



One Friday about eight years ago, Christina was on her way out of town for a weekend trip, when she realized she had forgotten something. When she ran back inside the house, the phone rang.

She says now that the Holy Spirit told her to answer the phone. It was Theresa Seiler asking her to coordinate the Holy Family Camp for 100 people. They needed someone to start the next week. Christina said she would start on Tuesday.

At the end of January each year, she starts working on the camp for that year. She stays overnight at the camp with the campers,

and her children help out with the camp. She gets volunteer help from Carroll and Kapaun students. Also five nurses stay the whole time.

There have also been volunteers from Boy Scouts, Knights of Columbus, Little Flowers, Daughters of Isabella, and Sisters of Sienna. At present, the camp consists of 80 – 90 campers and 80 – 90 volunteers.

The camp is open to people from ages 14 - 79. It fills up very quickly. The cost is \$160 per week, which does not cover the cost of the camp. During the week the participants attend Mass, go to Reconciliation, and have faith lessons. They also do crafts, have inflatables, a petting zoo, a clown, a photo booth, track and field competitions, and a dance.

The camp provides a good time for participants, and respite for the parents of children who have disabilities. It is the 26th year of the program.


